

'Complete The Cycle'

Over 1.2 million inhalers have been recycled and recovered. This has saved the same amount of CO2 emissions equivalent to taking 5,199 cars off of our roads!

Inhaler Recycling Scheme

Although most local authorities provide a recycling service, some inhaler components contain materials that are not able to be recycled through the service provided by local authorities. If inhalers are not disposed of correctly then it is likely that they can end up in landfills or sent for incineration with energy recovery. When disposed of in this way the inhalers pose a huge risk to our environment, in material waste AND greenhouse gas emissions caused by any gas canisters that may become pierced or crushed resulting in the release of the propellant.

Complete the Cycle facilitates a safe and responsible way to recover all inhalers. This scheme ensures that all of the recyclable parts of the inhaler are used in the manufacturing of new products such as plastic bottles, car parts and garden furniture. Any non-recyclable inhaler waste will be converted into electricity or heat using a process called 'waste to energy' whereby energy is created through the incineration of waste.
